Hello Libertarians,

Last week I told you about our convention. Once again, from myself and the outgoing and incoming Executive Committee and the Convention Committee, thank you for being a part of one of the most successfully attended conventions in party history.

Due to bylaw 8.3 subsection 8, we were not able to nominate a candidate for Governor at the convention this year. Subsequently, our Chair, Chris Holbrook, resigned before the convention's adjournment. Because of this, a motion to adjourn the convention was made, seconded and passed before accepting Chris' resignation.

His time as Chair has grown our party to where it is today. I see his resignation not as a negative but as a gained advisor, activist, and overall resource to help us for many years to come.
